SEPARATED BIKE LANES PROJECT



PROJECT BACKGROUND

The North Carolina Avenue NE Separated Bike Lanes Project is located in Ward 6, Washington, DC along the 1300 block of North Carolina Avenue NE. The project was designed to improve safety and comfort for cyclist and pedestrians along the project corridor and improve neighborhood connectivity and mobility for all modes of transportation through the project area.

PROJECT HIGHLIGHTS

- Permanent traffic change of North Carolina Avenue 1300 block from two way to one way westbound
- Improved overall pedestrian safety
- Maintains existing number of parking spaces along the project corridor
- Installation of protected bike lanes and raised crosswalk
- Updated pavement markings and street signs
- Improved traffic signal operation
- Enhanced streetscape and green spaces
- Replacement of deficient asphalt pavement
